Bulletin for St Thomas' & St Mary Magdalene's – Sunday 13th October – Trinity 20

Dear Friends,

I've always felt sorry for the rich young man in this Sundays Gospel Mark 10 : 17 – 31. He is obviously a good and faithful believer: he keeps all the commandments and has done from his youth, but Jesus perceives that his weakness is his wealth. "You lack one thing." Jesus tells him. "Go, sell what you own and give the money to the poor and follow Me." The young man goes away weeping, "for he had many possessions." There are several lessons to be learnt from this story. First, money can be a blessing and a curse: Paul says, "the love of money is the root of all evil." (I Timothy 6 : 10) and certainly desire for it has dire consequences for relationships with other people and with God. Think of the number of families who fall out when a will is read! With Thanksgiving Sunday on 27th October you will receive a letter today asking you to review your giving to the church. For some this will be a bone of contention but our plea has always been the Biblical injunction to give generously from the heart and only what you can afford: God loves a cheerful giver! The second lesson to be learnt is that the things that get in the way of the Kingdom are many and numerous, not just money. Often we hear about people struggling in life – sometimes the breakthrough is to stop focussing on yourself and look outwards to the needs of others and the value found in community. What things in your life are stopping you from following Jesus? Perhaps in the next week ask yourself the question, "What would Jesus do?" You may be surprised how liberating it is to, 'let go and let God.' Yours as always, Michael.
