## Bulletin for St Thomas' & St Mary Magdalene's - Sunday 17th November - Second Sunday before Advent

Dear Friends,

We are only two weeks from the beginning of Advent, the four weeks of preparation before Christmas. Next week is sometimes called 'Stir-Up Sunday' after the words in the Collect prayer, "stir up, O Lord, the wills of Thy faithful people..." so now is the time for us to get our act together spiritually so we are ready to welcome Jesus anew into our hearts and homes at Christmas. The sad fact is that we are often so bound up with the practical and commercial side of what should be a holy season that we don't give room for prayerful preparation. In todays' reading from Mark 13, sometimes called the 'mini-apocalypse', Jesus warns the disciples from thinking the Temple is the only place to find God, when it will be destroyed in time, and tells them to beware of false prophets who think they are God's gift to creation. In a world where celebrities and political leaders boast of millions of followers on social media, it is good to remember that God is King and His Son Jesus came into the world in poverty and not as a celebrity. He came to turn the world's values upside down: so this Advent take time to be holy and see God in the everyday; read scripture and let God speak to you; let the Holy Spirit (rather than selfish ambition) guide you; and remember that Advent is a time of giving and prayer:

- Attend the Advent Services on Wednesdays at St. Mary Magdalene's beginning 27<sup>th</sup> November
- Read Christine's 'Prophecies and fulfilment: Preparing to welcome Jesus'
- Give towards Christmas Food Bags and Christmas Cheer bags
